

Emporia – Care Recommendations

How to Care for Emporia Faucets

To maintain the aesthetic appearance and full functionality of your faucets for many years, regular and proper care is essential.

Daily Cleaning

We recommend gentle, regular cleaning of the surface using:

- a soft cloth or a delicate sponge,
- natural, non-abrasive cleaning agents (e.g., mild glass cleaners).

The best method for everyday care is to rinse the faucet with clean water and wipe it dry with a soft cloth. This helps prevent limescale buildup and water stains, while maintaining a polished finish.

Important: The fixture should be at room temperature during cleaning.

What to Avoid

Do not use:



products containing abrasive materials



preparations based on chlorine, alcohol, acids, alkalis, or solvents



aggressive detergents



rough sponges or brushes

Using improper cleaning agents may lead to damage of the coating and loss of the product's aesthetic qualities.

Proper Finishing of Cleaning

After each cleaning, you should:

1. Thoroughly rinse the surface to remove any detergent residue.
2. Wipe the faucet dry with a soft cloth.

Cleaning should be gentle — scrubbing may damage the surface.

Maintenance of Functional Components

To ensure proper operation of the faucet, you should:

- regularly clean connections from dirt and debris,
- check the condition of supply hose connections and mesh filters,
- keep the aerator clean.

If water flow decreases, it is recommended to remove the aerator and thoroughly rinse it under running water. We recommend performing this procedure once a month.

Thanks to the solid brass construction and durable protective coating, our faucets retain their functional properties and aesthetic appearance for many years — provided they are regularly maintained in accordance with the above recommendations.
